Dr. John Flanery is Assistant Choral **Director and Associate**

His Doctor of Musical Arts and Master's degrees are both in Choral Conducting from the University of Kentucky. He holds a Bachelor's of Music Education degree from Briar Cliff University in Sioux City, Iowa. At Southern Miss, John teaches choral conducting, choral procedures, and choral literature, directs the Concert Choir, Spirit of Southern, Men's Chorus, and the Southern Miss Gulf Coast Civic Chorale. His ensembles have been selected to perform at various state and regional conferences and concert series. He founded the Festival of Choirs on the Mississippi Gulf Coast, which comprises the Civic Chorale and area high schools in a non-competitive concert. The Southern Experience Show Choir and Choral Camp was founded under Flanery's guidance with over 500 junior high and high school students and teachers attending in its first four years.
